EXCEPCIONAL OPERATING SITUATION – ZERO LEVEL – UNAVAILABILITY OF EUSKADOUR COMPRESSOR STATION



On February 8th 2023 an incident occurred in the electrical transformers that feed the motor compressors of the Euskadour compression station. Since then repair works have been carried out and the facility's situation is certainly better, even though 100% availability has not been reached yet.

Until the facility is fully repaired, a 195 GWh/d capacity will be granted; however, after the repair work is carried out and in order to maximize the use of the interconnection through the VIP Pirineos, **the operating conditions of CI Irún have been temporarily and extraordinarily modified in coordination with the adjacent French operator, so as of April 1st, and until further notice, an attempt will be made to increase the utilization capacity up to a nominal 225 GWh/d**

In the event that operating conditions evolve in such a way that full capacity cannot be met, the sector will be duly informed by updating this Operation Note.

It is reported that the declaration of Exceptional Operation Situation level ZERO (SOE-0) is still valid in accordance with section 10.6 of the NGTS.
